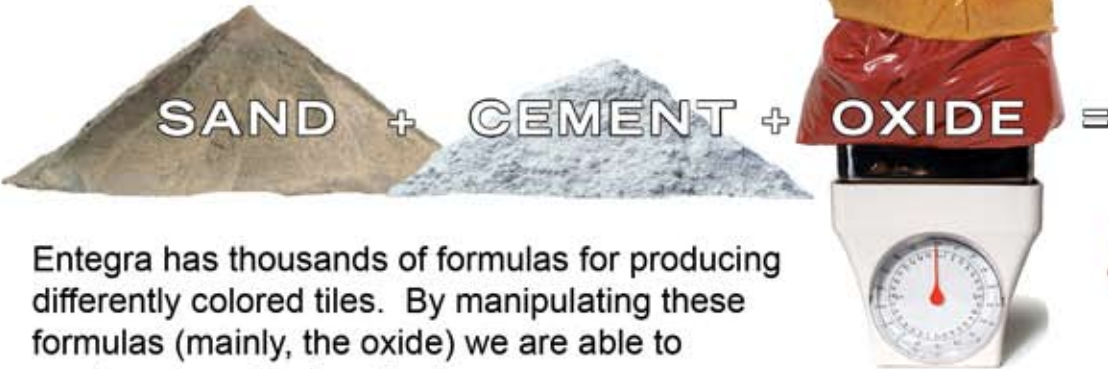

COLORED CONCRETE

How It's Made



Entegra has thousands of formulas for producing differently colored tiles. By manipulating these formulas (mainly, the oxide) we are able to produce new shades of colors.

If you desire a Custom Color, our production team will begin with the formula of a previously manufactured color. They will use their knowledge and experience to tweak the amount of oxide to best produce your desired color. For each sample attempt, an entire batch of concrete must be made (that's enough to produce 500 tiles), and it often takes several sample attempts before producing a close match.

Color consistency in concrete products is very difficult to maintain because of the raw materials these products are manufactured with, which often vary from load to load, sometimes even within a load. Temperature, humidity and the curing process also play a role in the final outcome of each tile.

Although this process is difficult, Entegra has the most sophisticated concrete mixing and coloring systems for making concrete roof tiles in the state of Florida. Our batching equipment provides the foundation for consistent tile and reduces problems associated with color. Additionally, our technologically advanced equipment ensures consistent dimensions and curing parameters which help minimize issues with color.

We strive to accommodate Custom Color requests and provide our customers with satisfying results. We have many processes in place to minimize color variability, and because colored concrete will always have some variance, we feel it is important you understand the process.
